BRACKENRIDGE PARK & CAMPGROUND

The Brackenridge Park & Campground consists of 275 acres. There are 134 campsites including 36 Partial hook-ups (water and electricity); 82 Full hook-ups (water, sewer, and electricity); and 16 Pull through sites which are full hook-up. All campsites offer 20, 30 or 50 amp electricity for R.V.'s and Motor Homes.

FACILITIES:

The facilities include the Harry Hafernick Recreation Center, a Pavilion, Marina Building, Historical Texana Church, and a Gazebo. For pricing and availability please contact the Brackenridge Park Office.

CABINS:

Five cabins, located along the shoreline of the Marina Cove, are available for rent. Each fully furnished cabin provides two bedrooms with queen size beds, a living room and kitchen area. A handicap cabin is available upon request.

COMFORT STATIONS:

Four comfort stations are located within the campground; they are climate controlled and provide showers and restrooms. Washers and dryers are located in Comfort Stations 1 & 3.

ACTIVITIES:

Brackenridge Park has Miniature Golf and Disc Golf that are free to use; rental clubs and disc are available at the park office.

A Catch and Release Pond, located near the Main Event Center, is stocked with bass and catfish, has covered picnic tables, two large fishing piers, and a swing set nearby.

The Texana Park & Campground consists of 600 acres. There are 141 campsites including 78 Partial hook-ups (water and electricity) and 63 Full hook-ups (water, sewer, and electricity). All campsites offer 20, 30 or 50 amp electricity for R.V.'s and Motor Homes.

DAY-USE AREA:

The Day-Use Area is a great place for picnicking, playing on the playground, playing volleyball or fishing. There is also a boat ramp. fishing jetty and pier nearby.

FACILITIES:

A Pavilion is available to rent and includes water, electricity, and a barbeque pit. There are also restrooms nearby.
